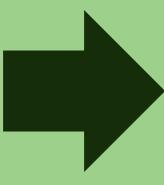

# Brand Introduction

While Curry County locals know and love the region, the name alone lacks geographic clarity for visitors unfamiliar with Oregon's counties. A tourism brand tied solely to a county name often underperforms in digital searches and traveler recognition. "Oregon's Wild Rivers Coast" bridges that gap-honoring the county's identity while aligning with how visitors plan their trips. Including "Oregon" in the name improves search engine optimization (SEO), and generative engine optimization (GEO) helping potential travelers discover the researching when coastal area destinations, road trips, and river adventures in the Pacific Northwest.

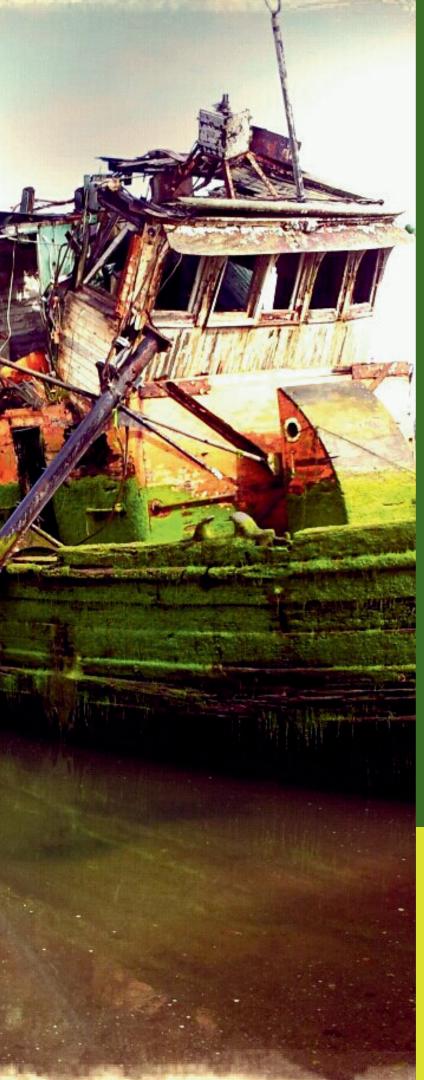












#### Logo Usage

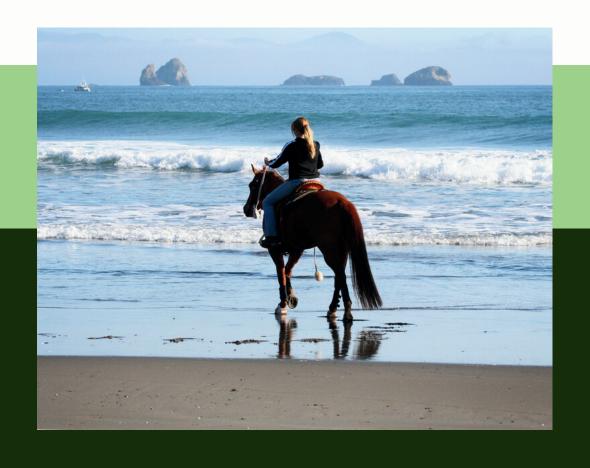
